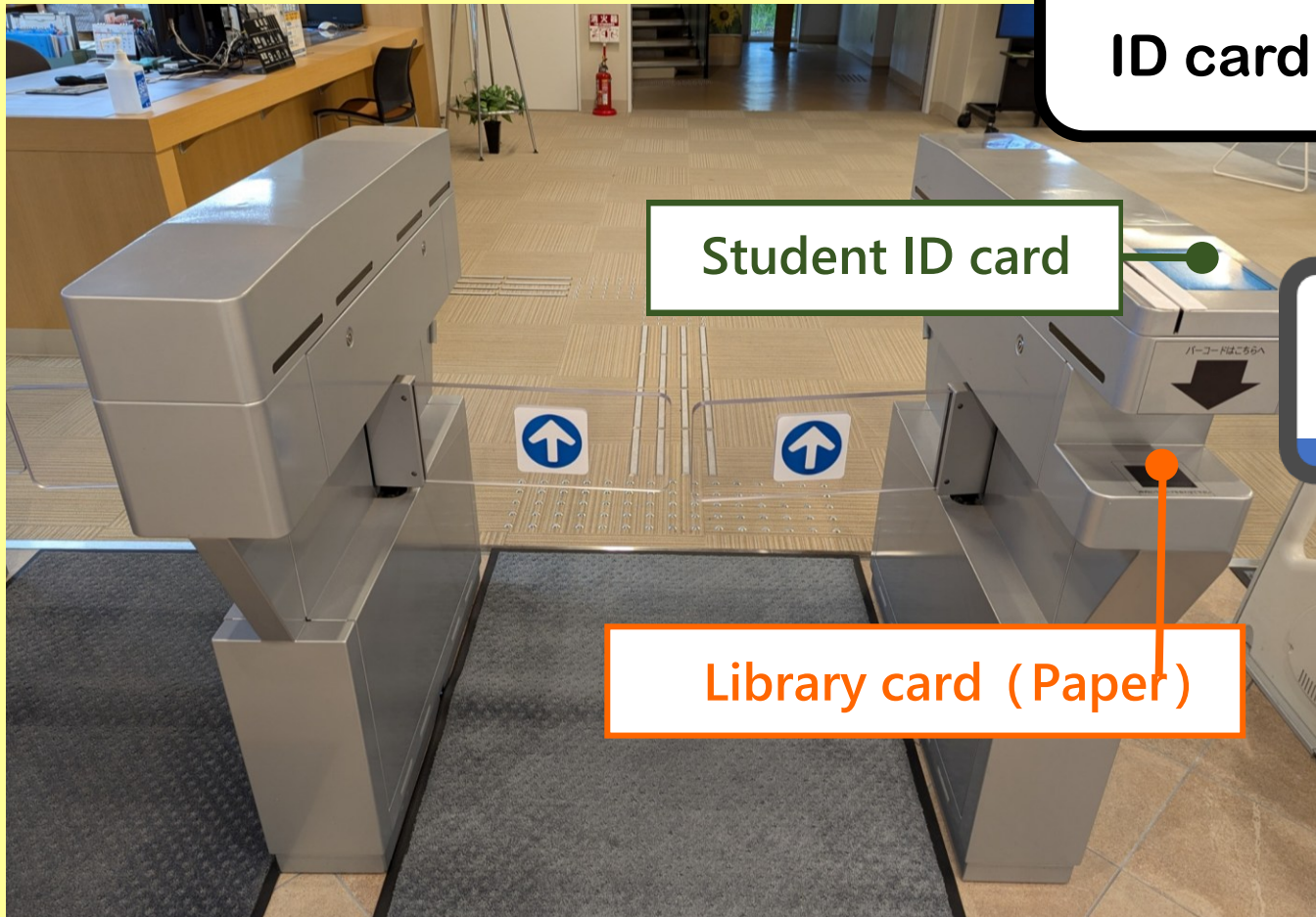
A brick building with three stories located on the east campus.

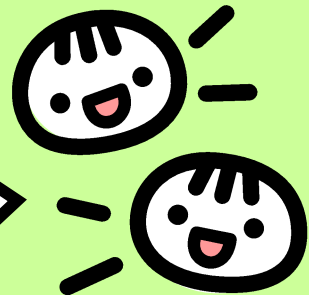
Circulation and reference desk to check in and out library materials and answer your questions.

Today's newspapers, special exhibits (e.g. Museum and Library cooperated exhibit) area, and a copy machine.



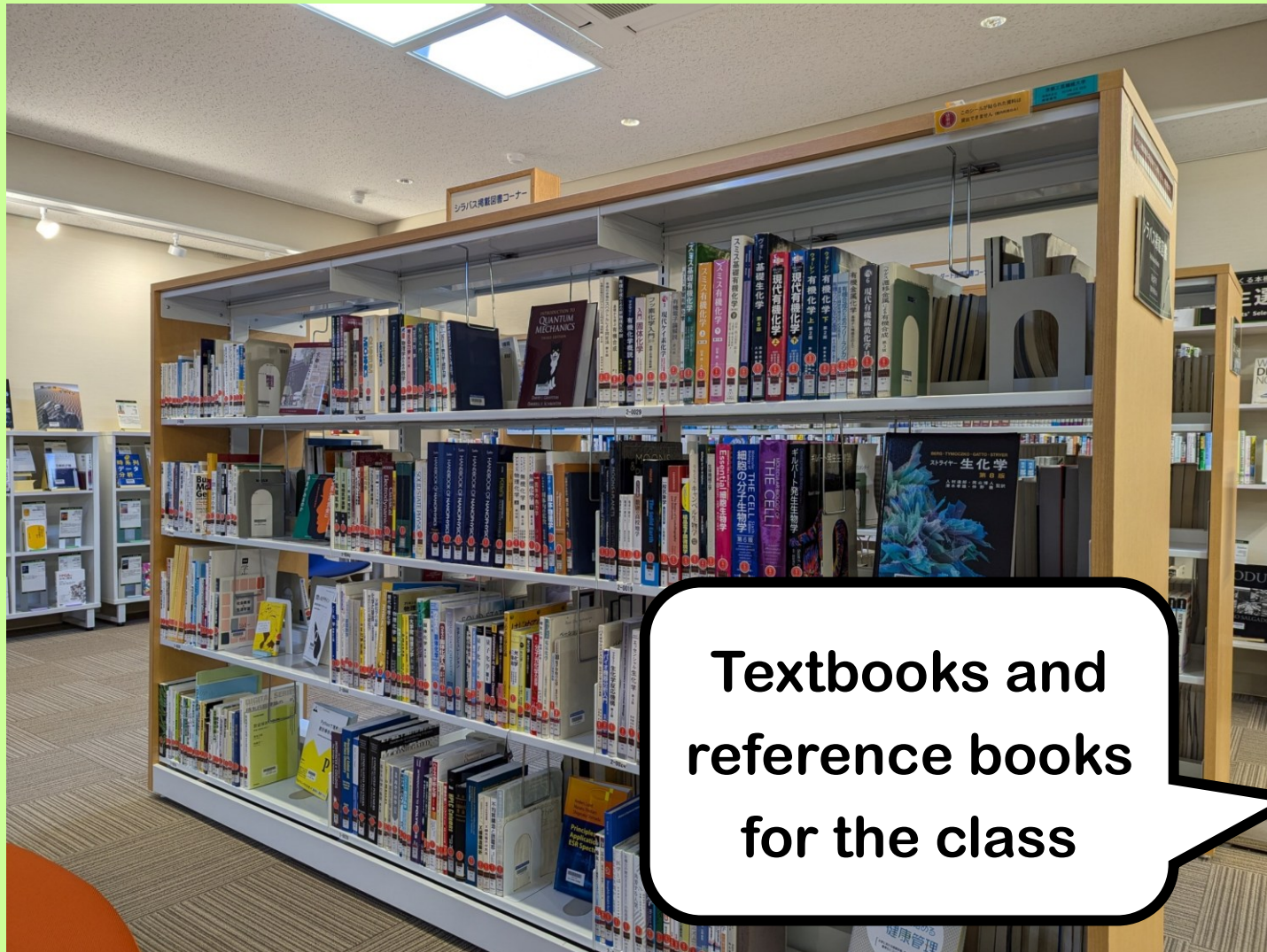

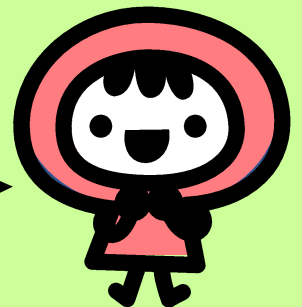
