ENTRANCE SECURITY

You need a student or a staff ID card, or a member's card to use the library. hold your ID card over the reader at the counter.

*Required card

- Undergraduate and graduate students: student ID card
- Faculty and staff: staff ID card
- Others (Alumni, Research students, Partner university students): require a member's card (apply at the information counter)



Loans

Bring your library card and the items you wish to borrow to The 1F information counter.

Returns

During opening hours: return books at the information counter. After closing and on holidays: return book at the drop box.

– if books are returned late, privileges will be suspended for the same number of days that the books or other media were late.

Renewals

Before the due date, you can renew items once. Ask at the information counter or renew through "MyOPAC". Periodicals are non-renewables.

Reserving books and other media

You can reserve items on loan through "MyOPAC" or at the information counter.

Book Requests

All KIT Library card holders can request materials for research and learning. See the library website for more information.

REFERENCE SERVICES

Ask library staff any questions when you need assistance finding materials or using databases.

A letter of introduction to visit other libraries can be issued on request.

Interlibrary Loans

Copy fee and postage will be charged on the users.

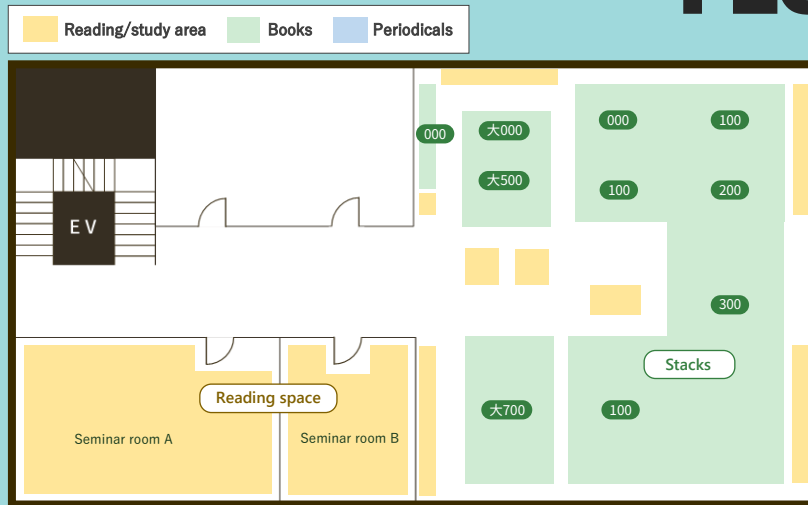

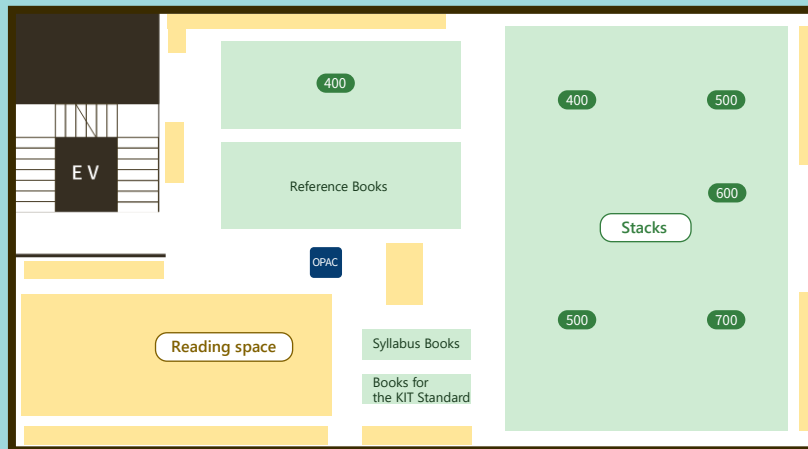

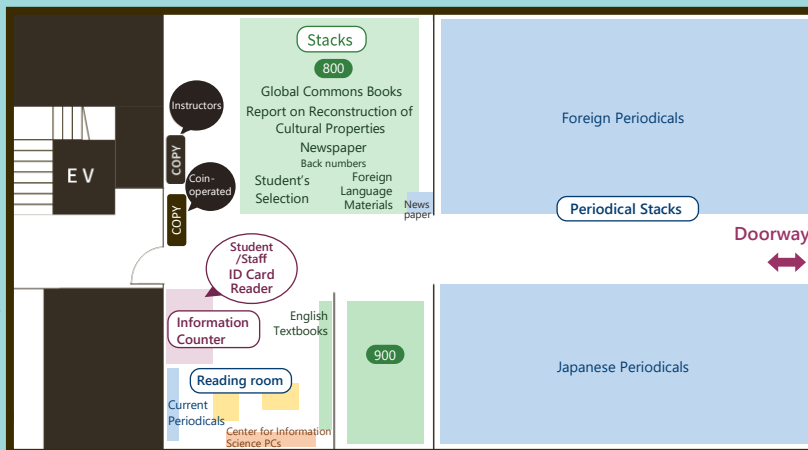
